

Education Brigade Workshop 2/19/2022

It was a packed house with over 70 attendees – 20 more than we were expecting – at the Education Brigade Workshop/Breakfast. The energy was high with lots of excitement as both men and women filtered in to hear our speakers. Among the attendees were NvFRW president, Caroline Smith, Roger Edwards, from the Republican Men of Reno, Amy Brown, wife of Captain Sam Brown (running for Nevada Senate) and Dr. Fred Simon (running for governor). Our speakers included WCSD Trustee Jeff Church, John Eppolito, founder of Protect Nevada Children, Kathryn Kelly, found of ISchool, Ciara Pegoda, president of Battle Born Moms for Education and Sas Hadden, home-school expert.

Some of the things we learned were:

Our WCSD Schools were recently ranked #49 in Education Week

Social & Emotional Learning has infiltrated every class subject and is another word for CRT

Third-party vendors are collecting sensitive data on our kids – the most massive database ever

Kids not only thrive in home-school and private schools such as ISchool – they are 2-3 grade levels ahead of their peers at public schools.

Several of our school board candidates practiced their campaign speeches before our meeting concluded.

Next RWR Education Workshop: Friday, March 18, 9:00am. Don't miss this one – Robert Beadles will provide us with an update on the Recall of Angie Taylor.

The County Commission/Health District Brigade has continued its engagement at the respective public meetings. The focus of the Brigade's initial efforts was on demanding the Commission end the "Public Health Emergency", ban mask mandates, ban mandatory Covid-19 vaccinations and ban vaccine passports/verification to employment or engaging in business commerce.

Nevada has remained under a declared "State of Emergency" per NRS 414 since March 12, 2020. At time of writing this report, Nevada is in Day #714 of this declared "emergency." The Washoe County Commissioners, except for Commissioner Jeanne Herman, maintained the position they had no power to interfere, intervene or otherwise block the unconstitutional directives implemented by the occupier of the governor's mansion. Disappointingly, they refused to pursue the remedies exercised by Lander County in May 2021.

On December 14, 2021, the Commission finally lifted the county's emergency declaration and stopped enforcing the mask mandate in county chambers. On February 10, 2022, the state mask mandate was lifted. The lifting was a political science decision, not a medical science decision. The facts on efficacy of masking, social distancing, etc. will be for those more educated to debate than I. Common sense, however, has been crystal clear to all who have engaged with the Brigades: none of these governmental actions made any sense.

Most recently, over 300 citizens from the Brigades, numerous grassroots action groups and concerned citizens attended the Commission meeting on February 8, 2022, to give public comment on Election Integrity. Subsequent to the meeting, Commissioner Herman, assisted by the county's attorneys, crafted a resolution with 20 points of correction to strengthen election security for 2022. The item was submitted to County Manager Eric Brown, who forwarded the resolution and paperwork to "county staff" to place on the agenda for the 2/22/22 meeting.

Apparent duplicitous sabotaging of her paperwork perpetrated by unnamed "staff" resulted in an altered version of Commissioner Herman's resolution being placed on the 2/22/22 agenda (item #14). A coordinated attack against the proposals led by Commission Vice Chair Alexis Hill, the Nevada Democrats and other operatives forced the item to be removed from the agenda. It was a shameful abuse of a duly elected representative of the people and a failed attempt to paint her as someone who broke the Open Meeting Law.

Over 200 citizens attended the 2/22/22 meeting, including some in opposition to the resolution. All gave public comment in support of Commissioner Herman and Election Integrity, and excoriated the Board of Commissioners in general for its disgraceful behavior and obvious avoidance of discussing Election Integrity.

There are forces greater (they believe) than the plucky, strong hearted citizens of Washoe County who want to crush the citizenry into submission. It is the responsibility and duty of #WeThePeople to educate ourselves on what our elected representatives are doing. We must prioritize and find the time and energy to engage the elected representatives and let them know when they are doing a GOOD job and when they are NOT representing the best interests of their constituents. We are certainly awakened to apparent corruption in all branches of government and when we find those rare elected representatives who are fighting to represent their districts, well, we must rally to their cause and help them in the effort.

The County Commission meets on the 2nd, 3rd and 4th Tuesday of the month at 10:00 am. You can find the calendar, agendas, videos of the meetings at <https://www.washoecounty.gov/bcc/>

The Washoe County Health District manages the area's health concerns & responses, including the Covid-19 response/mitigation. They meet the last Thursday of the month at 1:00 PM. The last couple of months they have met on Zoom - and you must preregister with the board's Clerk to give public comment. The meeting alert will include information if they are meeting at the county chambers or online. Their website is <https://www.washoecounty.gov/health/>

An email alert is sent before the meetings with briefings on items of importance, suggested talking points and action plans for critical engagement. What the Brigade has learned over the last year of engagement is our elected and unelected bureaucrats are drunk with power and government coffers overflowing with money from the CARES Act and ARPA. The artificial inflation of budgets with this indebted federal money portends future financial calamity for our county, I fear.

We welcome everyone to join the Commission or other Brigades to be informed on what is happening at the local level. It is my honor and privilege to lead this band of amazing Patriots as we work to return our county to Constitutional governance. Election Integrity On The Rise

Our second Election Integrity Workshop at Paisan's Deli on February 25th was attended by 75 engaged Patriots. We learned about what is going on Nationwide, Statewide and locally with regard to election fraud. One aspect of voter roll manipulation is the system called 'Eric.' This is a system the left is trying to adopt on a national scale with a national record of voters. As we know, the larger the bureaucracy the larger the fraud. We must fight to keep elections controlled at the community/county level to have control of election integrity, including and especially the voter rolls.

There were several Republican groups and organizations represented at our Workshop. The beauty of this is that people learned several ways to get involved. Jim Marchant, candidate for Nevada Secretary of State is working on a national level with influential Republicans who also know the 2020 election was rigged. Alida Benson with the Nevada State GOP gave specific examples of the shenanigans and outright cheating going on statewide. Several Patriots were able to tell us what they and their groups are doing toward election integrity. Our workshops are full of action items.

One of the longest running suspicious voter phenomenon in Washoe County appears to be the manipulation or mishandling of voter rolls over a period of decades. At the worst the numbers have been intentionally manipulated. At the least, the Registrar's office has been mishandling voter records because of ineptness. Per the Washoe County Registrars' CDs that they have provided over the years, the numbers consistently show more votes than voters. We are talking about possibly tens of thousands of dead people, out-of-state people, fictitious people and duplicated people.

Now that 'We the People' are running for office and becoming engaged in the election process, we can Make Nevada Red Again. It won't be easy. People will need to make sacrifices. We will need to give of our time and our talents. We will have to find time between earning a living, spending time with our families, and our worship. But God is surely with us, and not the collective Left that has lost its mind.

We are on the front line - in the trenches - volunteering in the shadows of our Founding Fathers to save the Republic that so many have fought and died for. Your efforts to engage other Patriots and to be engaged yourself, is why 'We the People' will prevail.

Recall Angie Taylor, WCSD Board President

School board dramas have been playing out all across the country and our own Washoe County School District (WCSD) has a starring role.

This past year saw the resignations of three board Trustees and the district superintendent. The board president tried to remove the only conservative on the board with a public censure - it failed. Two lawsuits were filed against the district – both about Open Meeting Law Violations.

And, most recently, a recall petition was initiated to oust the board president, Angie Taylor.

At the heart of all the trouble is the fact that the WCSD ranks at the bottom of the barrel in academics.

- Only 28% of our high school students are proficient in Math
- Only 48% of our high school students are proficient in English
- Only 19% of our high school students are proficient in Science

- 50th (dead last) in ACT scores across the nation

And yet, the school board continues to look the other way. They refuse to place Quality of Education on their agendas, despite the constant requests to do so.

Instead – the board prefers to keep a sharp focus on Social Justice (Critical Race Theory) and Social & Emotional Learning (SEL). They are indoctrinating our kids with political ideology – instead of educating them in the 3Rs. One U.S. History teacher declared, “I will not be teaching history to you this year – instead, I will be teaching Black Lives Matter and LGBTQ topics.” Unbelievably, she is still employed!

It is no wonder that only 13% of our students are college-ready – with most having to take remedial classes in college.

And although our school district can no longer provide bus services to students, they are hiring another full-time Equity & Diversity teacher.

Our kids deserve better!

If the school board won't heed our calls to focus on Quality of Education, our only option is to recall president Taylor and replace her with someone who will make the improvements we need.

American Athletes Bought Out in the Beijing Olympics

If you take a look at the teams competing for China in the 2022 Beijing Olympics, you'll notice that a significant number of them aren't Chinese at all. Rather, their teams consist of quite a few foreign athletes – recruited to win medals and to promote China's international status.

For instance, Californian skier Eileen Gu competed and won several medals in freestyle skiing events for China. When asked how she could access Instagram in Beijing, Gu asserted that “anyone can download a [VPN]” and that it was “literally free on the App Store”(Papenfuss). In actuality, however, Gu is an exception. China has banned the use of personal VPNs, and citizens caught using them are issued heavy fines, or worse, as punishment. Shortly after Gu's response, a Weibo user shared a screenshot of her comment that went viral, complaining “Literally, I'm not 'anyone.' Literally, it's illegal for me to use a VPN”(Papenfuss). From this, it can be concluded that Gu is either ignorant of the situation for millions of other Chinese citizens or chose to lie with full knowledge that she was in a privileged position.

Additionally, when confronted with the topic of former Chinese tennis player Peng Shuai, Gu “skirted around the issue of [her] safety as she insisted the Chinese tennis star [was] ‘happy and healthy’”(Massle). Reportedly, the room in which Gu had made this statement was “full of Chinese volunteers and media, who grew quiet when the tennis player was mentioned”(Massle). Peng Shuai caught international attention when she disappeared after making sexual assault allegations against a high-ranking Chinese government official. The subsequent takeback of her allegations was odd and her appearances on Chinese media appeared to be heavily monitored, despite Chinese authorities insisting that she was acting of her own accord. Ironically, Gu presents herself to be a strong advocate of gender equality and representation of women in sports.

In fact, Eileen Gu isn't even a special case. There are numerous cases of successful Americans being bought out to act as mouthpieces for the Chinese government. Our nation is supposed to be a beacon for liberty; an embodiment of basic rights and freedoms. Are we not going to stand for these core principles simply because it's profitable to turn a blind eye? A significant portion of Americans are just ignorant of the human rights abuses happening in China right now, and therein lies the problem. We need to educate ourselves and our communities on the true situation in China – not just the sanitized story that their government would like us to propagate.


