

Early Voting and Mail-In Ballots

- Even though "Early Voting" at the polls starts on May 28 and goes through June 10 – mail-in ballots may be arriving in early May.
- That means that people may be using their mail-in ballots to vote instead of voting in person.
- Please talk to your friends and neighbors and get the word out about our conservative and Republican candidates.
- To be on the safe side and to avoid voter fraud, we are advising people not to use the mail system for your completed ballots.
- Please walk your completed ballots into the Registrar of Voters office and hand them over to a live person.



DID YOU KNOW

- * Neanderthals are ten times closer to modern day humans on the evolution chain than chimpanzees.
- * About 8,000 guns were detected in luggage in 2021. This year, 1,800 have been found. 86% of them were loaded.
- * More Americans are breathing unhealthy air than ever before. The 'Sunburn of the Lungs' comes from higher levels of particle pollution; climate change, wild fires and smog, mostly from car exhaust pipes.

- * In 1935, the world's first automatic parking meter was installed in Oklahoma City, OK. The Park-O-Meter charged motorists a nickel to park from 15 minutes to an hour.
