## Drag Queens in the Libraries are on the Library Board Agenda

While Arizona and Nevada continue to compete for last place in the counting of our ballots, this Wednesday, November 16th at 4pm at the North Valleys Library, 1075 North Hills Boulevard, the Washoe County Library Board will be meeting to discuss Drag Queen Story Hour. We have been working to get the Library Board to eliminate this program but the Library Director, Jeff Scott insists that it will remain. In communities across this country this program has been used to indoctrinate and groom our kids into accepting this behavior as normal.
